## **New Students**

The Geraldton Grammar School Instrumental Music Program (IMP) offers music tuition to students from Years 5-12 through weekly instrumental lessons and ensemble rehearsals. If you would like to enrol your child in the Instrumental Music Program, please complete the attached form and return it to the front office no later than **Friday, 21 November 2025**. It is imperative that all applications are signed and returned by this date to ensure that your child has the best opportunity to secure a spot in the program and hire instruments and book packages are ready for the start of Term 1, 2026. All applications will be assessed by the Director of Music using set criteria.

Students in the IMP are required to participate in at least one of the school ensembles. Depending on their chosen instrument, students can join the Senior or Junior Concert Band, Jazz Band, Guitar Ensemble, and Rock Band. Appointments to an ensemble will be made by the Director of Music, when the student has enough experience on their instrument.

In 2026, bursaries and scholarships are available for the following instruments:

• Trombone, Baritone Horn, Tuba, Bass Guitar

Please contact the Director of Music if you wish to apply for a bursary or scholarship.

Success in learning an instrument is largely determined through a student's commitment to individual practise, and parental support. Each instrumental tutor at Geraldton Grammar has their own recommended practise schedule but all advocate for shorter, more frequent practise sessions throughout the week as the best way to progress. Please consider and discuss with your child whether they will be able to commit to practising multiple times per week and meet their commitments to an ensemble.
