BUSINESS CONDITIONS

Enrolment Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of \$70 including GST is payable with the completed enrolment application form.

Notification of Acceptance

As applications for enrolment are received, parents will be formally notified and offered an offer and acceptance. Parents accept the offer of a place by returning to the School the Offer and Acceptance and required documentation.

Endowment Fee

A non-refundable endowment fee of \$700 for the first child plus \$100 for each additional child enrolled from the same family, up to a maximum of \$900. Payment of the Endowment Fee is required at acceptance.

Acceptance of Contract

By signing the Enrolment Application form and the Offer of Acceptance, parents have agreed to be jointly and severally liable for all fees and other payments. The details of the Fees and Business Conditions forms part of the Offer/Acceptance contract signed by parents with Geraldton Grammar School. Any request to vary this agreement must be made in writing.

Payment of Fees

Fees are charged on an annual basis, instalments of the fees and expenses are due and payable by the 14th day of each term. Methods of payment are set out on the statement of account. A late fee of \$150 will be charged on accounts not paid within fourteen days of the due date unless previous arrangements have been made. Costs incurred in the collection of overdue fees will be charged to your account.

Applications to participate in optional tours, camps and excursions may not be accepted unless all fees have been paid.

The School reserves the right to cancel a student's enrolment for non-payment of school fees. Enrolment may be cancelled at the end of a term if fees for that term have not been paid unless an approved payment arrangement has been made.

Concessions

The following concessions are allowed from Tuition Fees:

- 2.5%, provided the full year's fees are paid within fourteen days of the commencement of the first School term.
- 13.5% for the second child attending at the same time, provided all accounts are paid on time.
- 40% for the third and subsequent child attending at the same time, provided all accounts are paid on time.

Remission of fees will only be made in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Principal.

Other Charges

Other charges such as diaries, library bags, locker locks and online learning licences may from time to time be charged to accounts. These items may include GST

Booklists and uniforms are payable at the time of purchase and will not be added to annual accounts.

Student Accident Protection Plan

Scholarships

Change of Circumstances

Please notify the School Administration promptly of any alterations to the home address, email and/or phone number of any family member.

Notice of Withdrawal

One academic term's notice in writing must be given to the Principal before the withdrawal of a student from the School. Failure to give such notice will render parents or guardians liable for fees equivalent to 25% of the annual fee in lieu.

Withdrawal from the Instrumental Music Program will only be accepted in the first two (2) weeks of a school year. Any withdrawal following this will be liable for the full year fee.

Variation of Conditions

This schedule is effective from 24 November 2020. The details of the fees and business conditions form part of the offer and acceptance contract sign by parents on enrolment. The Board reserves the right to vary its fees and business conditions from time to time. Such current conditions or variations shall be outlined in each year's fee schedule or notified from time to time.
