Along with our traditional enrolment of students from the Mid West, we also have boarders from the Pilbara and from the south west of the State.

Support and Communication

Geraldton Grammar School provides a Geraldton Residential College Liaison who is the current Head of Secondary School, Simon Moffatt. Should you have any concerns related to boarding, please contact the Residential College itself or Simon Moffatt for assistance. From time to time, school staff will join the boarders for an evening meal to provide support and give the staff in the Residential College a chance to interact and communicate with the school.

Academic Support

Boarders have fully supervised study time each week in the school library on Wednesday for one hour after school. The Geraldton Residential College staff will deliver and collect students to and from the school in order to meet this academic requirement.
