Geraldton Residential College has an established reputation within the Geraldton community and throughout Western Australia. Our credibility is reflected in the confidence shown by families who send successive generations to reside within our walls.

The College is located within a 10-minute walk from the city centre and is adjacent to Geraldton Senior College campus.

The total capacity of the College is 126 students who come from all over the State, from as far north as Halls Creek and east to Meekatharra and south to Jurien Bay. Students range from 11 years old (Year 7) to 18 years old (Year 12).

Our College supports Positive Behaviour Support (PBS), and our PBS purpose statement serves to give our College direction: to create a positive experience for all at Geraldton Residential College, through the implementation of PBS. 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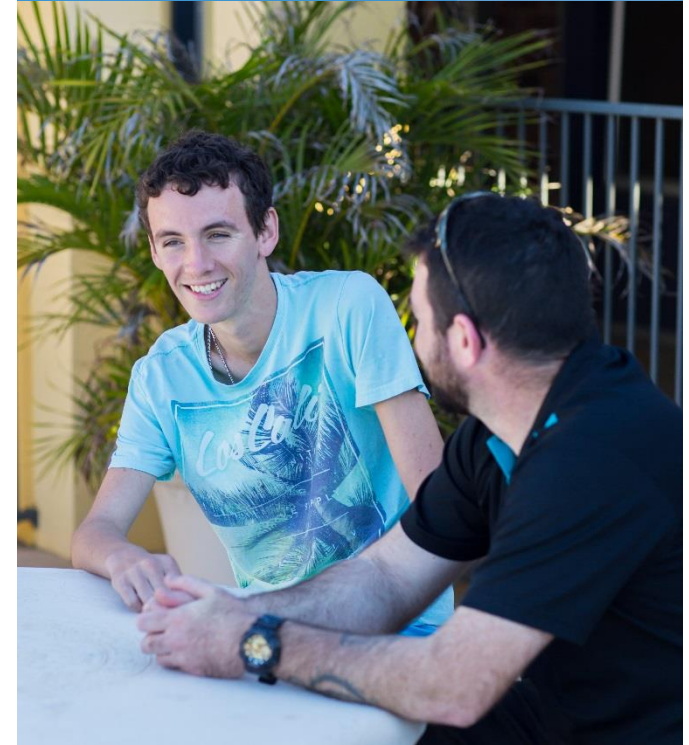

Modern Facilities

Recent upgrades to the College have substantially enhanced the boarding experience for our students. Improvements include 16 new bedrooms in the female student wing as well as upgrades to existing bedrooms, bathrooms, staff accommodation units and recreation areas. There is also shared accommodation for younger students, which helps students living away from home for the first time to feel supported by their peers. The College has a secure Wi-Fi network which is monitored 24/7 and is available to students in the common rooms and dormitory areas.

Healthy 'Home-Cooked' Meals

We are proud of our long history in providing home cooked meals and healthy food choices for our students, and our kitchen staff strive to meet all dietary requirements. We follow the Department of Education's *Healthy Food and Drink* policy to ensure we offer a balanced diet.

Produce is sourced locally where possible and is always fresh and of a very high standard. We aim to support local growers and businesses and do so by shopping locally.

Academic Support

Supervisors on duty support and guide the students at study time. In house tutoring options are available from time to time from qualified volunteers if required.

Social Development

We actively encourage all students to be involved in a sport or community activity outside of the College. We provide transport to and from their chosen sporting or community venue within the Geraldton area. It helps students to meet and make new friends.
